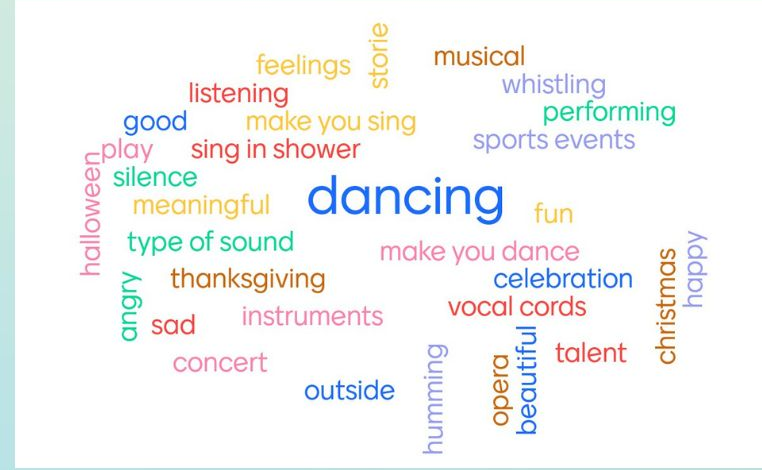

Our Project Timeline

- January to May

Part 1: Music is Art

Students learned about Kandinsky and other artists that have synesthesia. After learning about different artists students made their own valentine's rendition of Kandinsky's "Concentric Circles."

Part 2: Music is Feelings

Students discussed different emotions that people experience. After the discussion, students listened to and responded to 4 pieces of music by either drawing or writing what feelings they experienced.

Part 3: Music is Vibrations

As requested by the 3rd-grade team, we took a little detour and looked into how sound is made. Students made predictions about different instruments and also about how different surfaces would sound when interacting with a tuning fork.

Part 4: Music is celebration & dance!
